He left behind a wife, Carrie and a little girl, Sofia (4yrs old). I am in the process of organizing several benefits to raise money for John's family, the first of which is scheduled for November 15th. John was an unbelievable partner and friend, if you knew him you would understand why this is so important to me. John was always the first to lend a hand whether on the job or off. He never said no, and he always took care of those in need. John was known as the "gentle giant". He was 6'4" 250lbs but had such a calm and gentle way about him, which always served us well in emergencies. Since John was always the first to help anyone in need, his friends and family want to make sure his wife and daughter are cared for, in their time of need.
